After gaining access to victim's computer, actors fraudulently withdrew \$7,399.00 from his bank account. Furthermore, the victim provided the actor with \$4,500.00 in various gift cards as a bill payment for the McAfee Antivirus service. Total amount of monetary loss is \$11,899.99.
